JON ACKERSON COUNCILMAN - DISTRICT 18

Councilman Jon Ackerson attended Plainview Residents' Association Board Meeting on Wednesday, May 11, 2011 to offer assistance to our residents for large improvements to the subdivision. He requested itemized proposals with thorough descriptions of the improvements. This funding must meet criteria (A) serving the public good and (B) being clearly visible to the residents. The Board settled on two projects which we have been trying to fund for some time while yielding to immediate needs of the subdivision. These two projects to be submitted are (#1) a new entrance sign at the intersection of Whetstone Way and Timberwood Circle clearly defining the residential part of Plainview. The sign will be consistent with the new sign at Cambridge Station Road and Shelbyville Road having a stone wall and black sign. (#2) will be the completion of the final stage of irrigation to the subdivision located at Plainview Terrace Drive. The necessary forms will be submitted to 18th District Councilman Jon Ackerson who will walk the process through the proper channels to ensure our residents the best possible funding solution.
